

eMACS 25.3 Release

Feature Snapshot – Updates to All Modules

IMPORTANT:

The eMACS 25.3 Release upgrade will be promoted to the eMACS Production environment beginning Friday, November 14, 2025, at 7 PM MDT/MST through Sunday, November 16, 2025, at 10 AM MDT/MST. The Production environment WILL NOT be available to agencies or vendors during this time frame.

Agencies are asked to review events they may have opened during or around this time frame and consider if any action is necessary, i.e., extending the Open Date and, if applicable, the Q&A Submission Close Date. The Q&A Submission Close Date for the Q&A Board is often missed in this review.

Listed below are changes taking immediate effect on Monday, November 17, 2025. These changes should NOT affect existing functionality, permissions, or access rights.



Privacy Link Available from all Solution Pages

The JAGGAER Privacy Policy is available via a link at the bottom right of the browser window in the application. When the policy is updated, a message banner displays across the top of the page after login until dismissed by the user. With this release, a link to the JAGGAER Service Privacy Policy is available in the user menu in the top-right corner, as shown below.




Improvements to eMACS User Interface - Status Badges

The eMACS "Status" badges that appear on pages have been updated to be standardized across the eMACS modules.


User Impact

- The user interface (UI) of main list pages has been updated so that status badges appear in all relevant lists, and colors are uniform across all modules.
- List pages that appear inside objects, such as attachment lists have also been updated.




Obligations Enhancements

In the 25.2 release, various enhancements are being made to Contract Obligations, with much of the focus on the way they are managed and stored with eMACS.


User Impact

 We have modified how obligations are created and stored within the system, allowing for improved search results on both the Contract Obligation page and Obligations Across Contracts report.






- For each recurring obligation series, there is a display limit for those obligations that have a Due Date in the future. This limit is approximately 100 occurrences. Note: This is a rolling limit. As Due Dates drop off from being a future date, new obligations are added. This way, users will always have a "rolling" 100 future due date display of obligations for their recurring obligation series.
- There are no changes to how one-time obligations are displayed in this release.
- A new reminder text message will appear to notify users of this limit on both the Contract Obligation page and Obligations Across Contracts report.



- When a user changes either the Start Date or End Date of a contract that has a recurring
 Obligation that uses Start or End Date as the start of the recurring series, it may take the system
 some time to recreate/recalculate the obligations.
- Upon the Obligation page rendering, the Status filter defaults to the Overdue and Upcoming statuses. These statuses are also part of the default visible filters when navigating to the page (i.e., they are NOT hidden in More Options).



- Upon navigating to the Obligation page, the user will find the obligations sorted by **Due Date** (oldest to newest ascending).
- When using the Obligations Across Contracts report, users may now filter results by contract using either the Contract Number or Contract Name.
